



Frenchtown Broncs Invitational **Saturday, December 15, 2018**

Dear Coaches:

You are cordially invited to attend the Frenchtown Broncs Invitational Speech, Drama, and Debate Tournament on Saturday, December 15, 2018.

Location: All events will be held at the Frenchtown High School and Junior High. (The high-school building and junior-high building are attached to each other.) Bus drivers may drop teams off at the main high-school entrance and then just pull forward in the parking loop. They may not *park* in front of any entryway. The “team area” will be in the high-school commons. The tabbing room will be in the high-school library.

Registration: Registration will be handled online. You will receive emails containing tabbing assignments, speaker codes, maps, and other information on Friday, December 14. Please check your registration carefully and notify Adrienne Maxwell (Email: adriennedmaxwell@gmail.com; Cell Phone: 406-270-0914) immediately regarding any changes.

Entry Deadlines: Initial registration must be completed online no later than **November 19, 2018 by 5:00 p.m.** at <https://forensicstournament.net/FrenchtownInvitational/18>. After November 19, the Forensics Tournament site will *not* accept any new schools. Additions will be closed on November 29 at 5:00 p.m. Drops will be closed on December 13 at 5:00 p.m. so that we can begin sectioning events and finalizing rooms and judges. Drops after this time should be e-mailed to Adrienne Maxwell at adriennedmaxwell@gmail.com. If you have drops on the day of the tournament, then do not send an email. Entries: All teams are limited to 3 entries per event. Coaches may email requests for extra entries to Adrienne Maxwell at adriennedmaxwell@gmail.com. We will do our best to accommodate all requests, but we have to operate within our space limitations.

Entry Fees: Teams will be charged \$5 per competitor in each event, plus a \$10 team fee. There will be a drop fee of \$20 per competitor for all drops that occur on the day of the tournament. Invoices will be emailed to coaches after the tournament.

Rules: MHS A rules for Class A Competitions will be followed.

- Coaches are expected to monitor their students; students are to be reminded that they are guests and should act as such.
- No students may be in a classroom without a judge present.
- Cell phones may be used as timers but need to be in airplane mode during rounds.
- Debate topics will be as indicated in the MHS A Handbook.
- Debate Rounds 1 and 2 will be pre-paired. Round 3 will be paired based on the results of Round 1. Round 4 will be paired based on the results of Rounds 1 and 2.
- Comment Sheets may be printed on 8.5 x 11 paper.
- Three entries per school per event will count toward sweeps.

Food and Beverages: Full concessions will be available near the high-school gym; breakfast and lunch will be provided for coaches and bus drivers in the hospitality room.
