



Great Falls Central Catholic High School cordially invites you to compete in the First Annual Great Falls Central Debate, Speech and Drama Meet on **January 5, 2019** – The Great Falls Central Catholic New Year Invitational.

The Tournament will be hosted at the University of Providence with events at the Providence Campus and the Central Catholic Campus. GFCC is just a 5 minute drive from UP. When dropping off your team at UP, buses/cars can use the Sullivan Hall Parking Lot and the teams then walk to the Student Commons (building 2). At GFCC buses/cars can drop off participants at the front door.

**Registration:** is open now through December 20, 2018. <a href="http://forensicstournament.net/GFCCNYI">http://forensicstournament.net/GFCCNYI</a>. The Northern BC Division and Central A Conference have priority and a waiting list will be created for teams from other Divisions/Conferences. Events will be limited to two sections and will CLOSE AS THEY FILL. No registrations will be accepted after December 20. You can drop competitors online until December 20, and then e-mail us later.

**Fees/Payment:** Entry fees are \$5 per student (\$10/duo). Please plan to pay at registration in the lower level of the Student Commons building (building 2) at the University of Providence between 7:30 am and 8:30 am on Saturday, January 5.

**Events:** All ABC events will be offered. Entries are limited to three per event per school. If your classic groups have more than 2 competitors, register the first two and then contact Jason to add the other names.

Rules: The 2018-2019 MHSA rules apply.

**Timing:** B-C Rules apply, meaning you will be <u>**TIMING UP**</u>, except Debate Rules will control debate.


