## **Judging Requirements:**

Each participating school or organization is being asked to supply 1 judge per 2 entries for debate. Congress requires a school to provide 1 judge for every 5 entries. Judging names should be submitted at the time of registration. If you need to register judges but don't know their names yet, please use your school name with a number to indicate the judges you will be providing (i.e. Wilshire judge 1; Wilshire judge 2; etc.). A charge of \$50 per absent judge will be applied for schools who do not provide enough judges to cover their entries (or fraction thereof).
