

A Bill to Make Halloween to be a National Holiday

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS HERE ASSEMBLED THAT:

1. **Section 1.** The United States Federal Government will make Halloween a public holiday.
2. **Section 2.** The official day of Halloween shall be the last Friday of the month
3. October.
4. **Section 3.** This legislation will take effect on January 1st, 2021
5. **Section 4.** All laws in conflict with this legislation are hereby declared null and void.

A Bill to Tax Fast Food

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS HERE ASSEMBLED THAT:

1. **Section 1.** The United States Federal Government will put a tax on fast food.
2. **Section 2.** There will be a 15% tax on any food that is considered “fast food”.
3. These are foods that are high in calories and high in fats. A portion of the money
4. collected will go to funding cancer research.
5. **Section 3.** This bill will be enforced/overseed by the US Department of Health
6. and Human Services.
7. **Section 4.** This legislation will take effect January 1st 2020.
8. **Section 5.** All laws in conflict with this legislation are hereby declared null and void.

A Bill to Decrease Fossil Fuel Cars

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS HERE ASSEMBLED THAT:

1. **SECTION 1** The United States will put a tax on vehicles using fossil fuels, such
2. gasoline, and gasoline for cars.
3. **SECTION 2** All cars registered after 2045 will have to pay a tax percent of 30%
4. based on the value of the vehicle. The gasoline tax will raise to \$2 per . Failure to
5. follow these laws will result in 20 years in jail and \$100,000 dollars in fines, with a
6. bail fee of \$200,000.
7. **SECTION 3** This bill will be enforced by the U.S. Department of Transportation.
8. **SECTION 4** This legislation will take effect on January 1st, 2045
9. **SECTION 5** All laws in conflict with this legislation are hereby declared null and
10. void.

A Bill to Make All Colleges Free

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS HERE ASSEMBLED THAT:

1. **SECTION 1.** The United States will mandate that all public colleges not require
2. tuition fees.
3. **SECTION 2.** Students will still have to provide for their own textbooks, class materials and living expenses.
4. **SECTION 3.** This bill will be enforced by the U.S. Department of Education
5. **SECTION 4.** This legislation will take effect on January 1st, 2029
6. **SECTION 5.** All laws in conflict with this legislation are hereby declared null and
7. void.

A Bill to Get Rid of All Zoos in America

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS HERE ASSEMBLED THAT

1. **SECTION 1.** The United States Federal Government will ban all of the zoos in
2. the United States.
3. **SECTION 2.** The zoos will moved to sanctuaries and rescue facilities. Animals
4. that can adapt to being returned to their natural habitat will be released.
5. **SECTION 3.** This bill will be enforced by the US department of Agriculture.
6. **SECTION 4.** This legislation will take effect on January 1st 2030.
7. **SECTION 5.** All laws in conflict with this legislation will be null and void.
